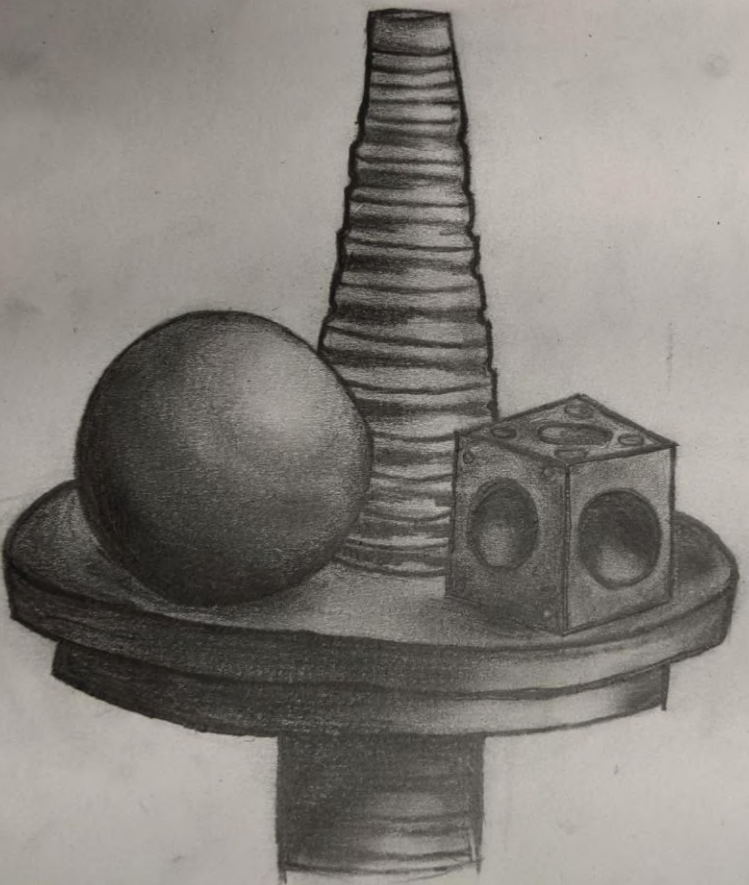
Year 7
